

IMPORTANT INFO

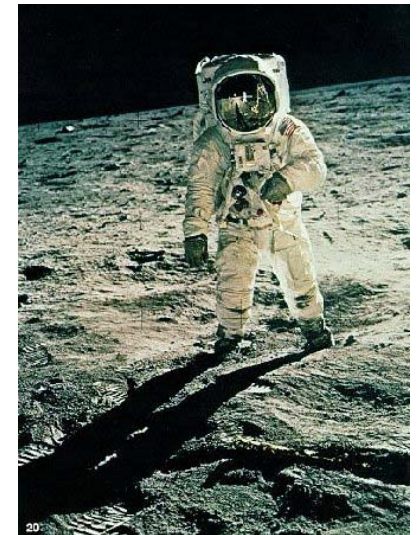
